Our facility is appropriately staffed with experienced caregivers providing the care and services to meet the needs of our patients.

As part of our continued infection prevention strategy, our healthcare personnel are trained in the proper use of personal protective equipment, hand hygiene (including alcohol based sanitizers), and respiratory hygiene. Our qualified environmental staff maintain stringent infection prevention protocol with EPA recommended and approved chemicals to clean all areas of our facility. Additionally, all staff are screened prior to the beginning of their scheduled shift to ensure any symptoms are immediately identified and, when appropriate, isolated to maintain patient safety. All non-essential visitation is strictly prohibited.

Continued communication between loved ones and their families is encouraged through video chat, calling, texting, or other social media platforms. Employees are ready to assist with any communication needs.

Please know that we are strictly adhering to all directions from the local and state health department. Our facility has a team of qualified medical professionals, under the leadership of our Medical Director, who are working in close partnership with such officials to spearhead the battle against COVID-19.
